JUNIOR AND SENIOR LEVEL PROGRAMS

To best focus the content and style of our Enrichment programs to distinct age groups, we offer two categories of programming – Junior (12-14) and Senior (15-17). Our Enrichment Programs are categorized into subject areas of Business, Communications, Leadership and Math & Science. Each area offers between 2 and 6 different weekly programs, allowing Participants to follow their interests, and explore diverse areas of programming.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR ALL PROGRAMS

- Devices such as laptops or iPads for class work are recommended. Cell phones are not permitted in Enrichment classrooms. Please see the Participant Code of Conduct on our website for full details.
- Students who are not enrolled in Before & After care are considered self-sign in/sign-out and are expected to go to their classrooms on their own.
- Appleby welcomes native and non-native English speakers to our Enrichment programs, and High English Language Proficiency is required. Applicants who are English language learners are asked to self-identify at the time of application and will require an online language assessment prior to acceptance.
- Civic Holiday: There is no programming on Monday, August 3, 2026. Shortened programs will be offered at 4-day pro-rated fees.

JUNIOR PROGRAMS

Our Junior Enrichment programs are designed for ages 12 to 14 and will accommodate students who are in grades 6, 7 and 8. These programs, while academic in nature, will provide more structured active time in addition to the classroom time to help engage and foster development in younger students. Junior Participants will receive 4 hours of in-class discussions, group activities and more. Exclusive for our Junior Participants, there are also 1.5 hours of active time each day where they can expect to be outdoors engaged in group games and active learning. Active footwear is recommended.

Program Structure:

- 1.5 hours classroom time
- Break
- 1.5 hours outdoor/active learning
- Lunch
- 2.5 hours classroom time

SENIOR PROGRAMS

Our Senior Enrichment programs are designed for ages 15 to 17 and will accommodate students who are in grades 9, 10 or 11 to ensure the class content is appropriately focused. These classes are structured and academic in nature to help develop and hone students' classroom skills and allow depth of content exploration. Students will receive 5.5 hours of classroom time and instruction per day where they will be engaged in class discussions, group activities and more.

Program Structure:

- 1.5 hours classroom time
- Break
- 1.5 hours classroom time
- Lunch
- 2.5 hours classroom time

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE OPTIONS

Before & After Care is available on a weekly basis for all Camps and Enrichment Participants. For our Enrichment Participants, this is an ideal option for families with younger siblings who are in Camps and who need supervision before and after programming. Families must pre-register for this service, and Participants will be entertained with a variety of activities organized by our camp instructors beginning from 7:30 a.m. until our extended 6:00 p.m. pick-up time. Both active and passive activities, as well as quiet spaces to read books brought from home are offered. Snacks are also provided in the morning and afternoon. Late fees will apply should Participants not be picked up by 6:00 p.m.

INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANTS

Appleby College welcomes Participants from all nationalities and language groups. To allow for the safest and most positive experience for all Participants, we offer specific weekly programs to non-native English speakers, who are required to meet a high level of English proficiency. All applications will be reviewed prior to confirmation, and an online English language assessment conducted. Agents representing international Participants, as well as international families looking for 3 or 4 week boarding programs, are asked to please contact summerboarding@appleby. on.ca prior to application.

An administrative fee of \$200/week will be charged for day Participants who do not hold Canadian citizenship or attend a Canadian school.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAM FEE INFORMATION

Enrichment Program Fees include all programs are led by experienced teachers and/or specially accredited instructors. Fees include a hot, nutritious lunch, with all dietary restrictions accommodated for (with the exception of Kosher). All programs are led by our qualified and extensively trained staff team, many of whom are experienced teachers and/or specialists in their respective areas of instruction. Appleby's scenic, 60-acre campus offers outstanding facilities and equipment, all of which are frequently utilized by our summer community.

STUDENT CONDUCT POLICY

Students are expected to demonstrate basic respect for the dignity and rights of others. The Assistant Director reserves the right to implement an established process and/or suspend and/or terminate the stay of any student who violates the Participant Code of Conduct, outlined in full detail on our website.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payments may be made by credit card and electronic cheque (eCheque). Payment via eCheque is an electronic version of a paper cheque used to make payments online. eCheques incur no transaction fees and are a convenient and secure method available to anyone with a bank account. Payments made by eCheque incur no fees; payments made by credit card will incur a 2.4% fee per transaction. Detailed instructions for both payment options are provided upon checkout.

WAITLIST POLICY

If a program is full at the time of application, families may choose to add themselves to the wait list. When families are contacted by the Academy Office with news of an available spot in (one of) their waitlisted program(s), they will have the choice to either accept or decline the offer within 24 hours, at which time all other spaces their student is waitlisted for in that week will be released.

WITHDRAWL AND REFUND POLICY

Notice of Participant withdrawal must be made in writing to the <u>Academy Office</u>. In a change from our previous policy, all registration cancellations are now subject to a **\$100 non-refundable fee per week of programming**, which will be retained from the total registration amount. This fee applies **regardless of the date of cancellation**. The remaining balance, if applicable, will be refunded according to our standard cancellation procedures.

Cancellations to Enrichment programs received after May 1, 2026 will not receive a refund. Exceptions to this policy are only given with proof of a medical emergency supported by certification from a legally qualified medical practitioner not related to the Participant, submitted to the Academy office by the final date of programming. Refunds will not be provided for inclement weather or for days of the program not attended. Changes to the program and/or program weeks must be requested a minimum of 30 days prior to the first day of the program and are accommodated pending availability. Cancellations to Before & After Care can be made up until 2 weeks prior to the start of programming, i.e., Before & After Care for Week 4 may be made up until the Friday of Week 2, etc.

Appleby College Enrichment Program will do everything possible to avoid program cancellations, however we reserve the right to cancel any session due to unforeseen circumstances or if the minimum enrollment is not met. In either of these instances, we will make every effort to accommodate students in an alternate program or alternate week, or provide families with a full refund. If payment was originally made via credit card, refunds will be processed back to the card on file.
