

INTERNATIONAL CAMPERS

International Day Campers: International Day Campers refers to International or non-local families temporarily residing in or visiting the Halton Region or Greater Toronto Hamilton Area during the summer.

Appleby College welcomes campers and students from all nationalities and language groups. To allow for the safest and most positive experience for all campers, we offer specific weekly programs to international campers. To ensure that we are able to offer a genuine, Canadian camp experience to all participants, the number of international students admitted to each camp program is limited. All applications will be reviewed prior to confirmation. Preference for spaces is given to students travelling as part of an officially registered CEC (Canadian Experience Camp) group.

*** An administrative fee of \$200/week will be charged for international day campers who do not hold Canadian citizenship.
Please note this does not apply to CEC campers***

Please refer to the refund policy as it applies to all local and international campers.

CAMP PROGRAM FEE INFORMATION

Camp Program Fees include supervision by Appleby Camps staff, all of whom are certified in Standard First Aid and CPR-C, have a police check and are extensively trained in Appleby's camp training program. All programs are led by our qualified and extensively trained staff team, many of whom are experienced teachers and/or specialists in their respective areas of instruction. Instructor to camper ratios are 1:5 for the Discovery Camps (ages 4-7) and for all other camps the maximum instructor to camper ratio is 1:8. Fees include a hot, nutritious lunch, with all dietary restrictions accommodated for (with the exception of Kosher) and frequent swimming in our indoor pool. Appleby's scenic, 60-acre campus offers outstanding academic, arts, and athletics facilities and equipment, all of which are frequently utilized by our camper community.

CAMPER CONDUCT POLICY

Campers are expected to demonstrate basic respect for the dignity and rights of others. The Director reserves the right to implement an established process and/or suspend and/or terminate the stay of any camper, who violates the camper Code of Conduct based on the following guidelines: zero tolerance of physical or psychological abuse/bullying; lack of respect for camp property and the property of others; behaviour that requires supervision beyond a reasonable level or behaviour deemed inappropriate by Appleby College Camp staff. PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payments may be made by credit card and electronic cheque (eCheque). Payment via eCheque is an electronic version of a paper cheque used to make payments online. eCheques incur no transaction fees and are a convenient and secure method available to anyone with a bank account. Payments made by eCheque incur no fees; payments made by credit card will incur a 2.4% fee per transaction. Detailed instructions for both payment options are provided upon checkout.

WAITLIST POLICY

To help place as many campers into programs (and off of waitlists) as possible, we are introducing changes to the waitlist policy for both March Break and Summer Camp programming. When families are contacted by the Camp Office with news of an available spot in one of their waitlisted camps, they will have the choice to either accept or decline the offer, at which time all other spaces their camper is waitlisted for in that week will be released. Families will not have the option to decline one waitlisted spot, in the hope of getting into another camp. So please select your camps (and waitlists) carefully! Thank you for your cooperation in helping us get as many campers in their top choice of programs.

WITHDRAWL AND REFUND POLICY

Notice of Participant withdrawal must be made in writing to the Camps office if attending Camp (camps@Appleby.on.ca) or the Academic office if attending Enrichment or Credit programming (academy@appleby.on.ca.)

In a change from our previous policy, all registration cancellations are now subject to a **\$100 non-refundable fee per week of programming**, which will be retained from the total registration amount. This fee applies **regardless of the date of cancellation**. The remaining balance, if applicable, will be refunded according to our standard cancellation procedures.

Cancellations to Camp, Enrichment, ESL Day or Credit programs received after May 1, 2026 will not receive a refund.

Exceptions to this policy are only given with proof of a medical emergency supported by certification from a legally qualified medical practitioner not related to the Participant, submitted to the appropriate office (Camps/Academies) by the final date of programming. Refunds will not be provided for inclement weather or for days of the program not attended. Changes to the program and/or program weeks must be requested a minimum of 30 days prior to the first day of the program and are accommodated pending availability.

Cancellations to Before & After Care can be made up until 2 weeks prior to the start of programming, i.e., Before & After Care for Week 4 may be made up until the Friday of Week 2, etc.

Appleby College Camps & Academies will do everything possible to avoid program cancellations, though we reserve the right to cancel a course due to unforeseen circumstances or if the minimum enrollment is not met. In either of these instances, we will accommodate Participants in an alternate program/alternate week or provide a full refund. Refunds will be made via the original payment method used. Note that the 2.4% processing fee originally charged cannot be refunded.
